

GNGU Mid Amateur selection criteria 2024/5

*Revised 25 November 2024

The GN Mid Amateur team for the 2025 IPT at Royal Johannesburg (tbc) will be announced after the completion of the North West Mid Amateur Open (10 August 2025).

Players will qualify for the team on the following basis:

- Minimum of 14 12* completed tournament rounds (WD, NR or DQ are not counted towards the number of rounds played).
- Counting tournaments towards the selection will include: -
 - GNGU All Amateur Series
 - GNGU Closed
 - GNGU Mid Amateur and Senior Closed
 - All SAGA Mid Amateur National ranking tournaments
 - All SAGA Open National ranking tournaments
- All scores in each round will be used to compile a Domestic Order of Merit (DOoM), which
 will be published on the GNGU website. The top 14 rounds will be used to determine the
 players position on the DOoM.
- The published DOoM will reflect **all** players. Until a player has played the minimum of **14** 12 rounds, DNQ will appear next to their name. It is the player's responsibility to ensure they are eligible for selection by meeting the above mentioned requirements.
- A player with two offenses (WD, NR or DQ) may not be eligible for selection in the current season. Offences will be handled on merit by the selection committee.
- Adherence to all tournament conditions in terms of behaviour and golf etiquette.
- Specific allowances may be made for players who only become eligible for Mid Amateur status or join GNGU during the course of the selection period, as they may not be able to gain entry to sufficient GolfRSA or GNGU events.
- SAGA rankings will be used as a further guideline if needed.
- The top 5 players according to selection criteria counting tournaments and DOoM will automatically be selected, 1 player of colour according to the GolfRSA SAGA tournament conditions, while the final 2 players may be selected as wild cards.
- If selected to represent GNGU, players will be expected to make themselves available to play stipulated practice rounds, including foursomes events. If a player elects not to participate in these rounds he may be replaced by an additional wild card player. This requirement will only be waived in exceptional circumstances.

*The Selection Committee reserves the right to amend these published conditions in exceptional circumstances. It must be remembered that the aim of the selection process is to identify a team of players that can represent the Union with dignity and honour.
