

WOMENS GOLF SOUTH AFRICA

TOURNAMENT DIVISIONS

Following the implementation of the USGA Course Rating System in South Africa and the introduction of the Handicap Index and Course Handicap, the following Divisions shall apply to WGSA National and Provincial Championships and the WGSA Medal (effective from 01 January 2019) and are recommended for Club competitions.

A Players Handicap Index (HI) shall determine the Division in which they play.

A Players **Course Handicap (CH)** shall be used for determining NETT results and the allocation of Stableford points.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Clubs are encouraged to use either the 2, 3 or 4 Division Handicap parameters for their Club Championships.
